FREMONT, CA —Fourteen year old Pavan Gowda, a Fremont teenager, got an award from the White House Friday for his environmental work. The award Pavan Gowda received was the President's Environmental Youth Award.

Pavan has been supporting green concepts for most of his life. He started up a website called greenkidsnow.org when he was eight, which teaches kids how to fight climate change. He has also written [books](#), gives speeches, and even works with his school to set up conservation programs.



"And we also have a conference, the Green Kids Conference, where kids can come and showcase their environmental efforts, and their science projects and innovations," Pavan said.
